On seeing Approval Report no. SP 9.359 of 10.08.2018 of the Pharmaceutical and Medical Devices Directorate and notification no. 45.882E of 27.06.2018 of the National Agency for Medicines and Medical Devices, registered with the Minister of Health no. 32.110 of 27.06.2018,

Taking into account the provisions of: – Commission Regulation (EU) no. 712/2012 of 3 August 2012 amending Regulation (EC) no. 1234/2008 of 24 November 2008 concerning the examination of variations to the terms of marketing authorisations for medicinal products for human use and veterinary medicinal products; – Articles 774 h) and 781 (1) f) and (i) of Law 95/2006 on healthcare reform, as further amended and supplemented; – Art. 4 (2) a) and Art. 12 (9) of Government Decision no. 734/2010 on reorganisation of the National Agency for Medicines and Medical Devices and amendment of further ruling provisions, in line with Art. 7 (4) of Government Decision no. 144/2010 on the organisation and operation of the Ministry of Health, as further amended and supplemented,

the minister of health hereby issues the following Order:

Article 1 - On this Order coming into force, Order of the Minister of Health no. 279/2005 on approval of implementation of changes to marketing authorisations approved by the National Medicines Agency, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 294 of 7 April 2005, shall be repealed.
