**on approval of the rules for collection and reimbursement of costs for the
conduct of operations for disposal of expired and/or unused medicinal
products from the population**

On seeing approval report of the General Directorate for Public Health and Health Programs of the Ministry of Health no. 2.684R of 22.05.2024,

taking into account the provisions of Art. 244 (7) of Law 95/2006 on healthcare reform, republished, as further amended and supplemented,

in line with Art. 7 (4) of Government Decision no. 144/2010 on the organisation and operation of the Ministry of Health, as further amended and supplemented,

the minister of health hereby issues the following order:

Art. 1 - (1) The rules for collection and reimbursement of costs for the conduct of operations for disposal of expired and/or unused medicinal products from the population are approved.

(2) For the final disposal of the medicinal products mentioned in paragraph (1), public or private hospitals conclude contracts with authorised economic operators for the collection and management of waste.

Art. 2 - (1) *Public or private hospitals conclude separate contracts with health insurance houses for the reimbursement of expenses related to the disposal of expired and/or unused medicinal products from the population, mentioned in Art. 1, the model of which is approved through Order of the Minister of Health and of the Head of the National Health Insurance House.*

(3) The reimbursement of expenses resulting from the activities of disposing of expired and/or unused medicinal products from the population will be made based on a tax invoice, which will contain exclusively the service of taking over and destroying expired and/or unused medicinal products collected from the population.

(4) The reimbursement of the expenses provided for in paragraph (3) shall be made at a cost that may not exceed the value of 10 lei/kg.

Art. 3 - (1) Public or private hospitals, as provided for in Art. 2 paragraph (1), shall send the invoices referred to in Art. 2 paragraph (3) to health insurance houses on a monthly basis, by the 5th of the month following the month for which the reimbursement is made.

(2) Health insurance houses centralize the invoices received and transmit monthly to the National Health Insurance House, by the 10th of the month, the centralizer for the previous month containing the invoices issued according to Art. 2 paragraph (3).

(3) The National Health Insurance House shall monthly submit to the Ministry of Health the requests for sums related to the previous month, by the 15th of each month.

(4) The Ministry of Health shall allocate from the state budget, from the budget of the Ministry of Health, through transfers to the budget of the National Single Health Insurance Fund (FNUASS), by the 20th of the month, the sums requested in line with paragraph (3).

Art. 4 – This Order shall be published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.
