ORDER

on approval of the Index of Medicinal Products for Human Use, 2005

Taking into account provisions of Emergency Government Ordinance no. 152/1999 on medicinal products for human use, approved as amended through Law no. 336/2002, as amended, art. 4 h) of Government Ordinance no. 125/1998 related to the set up, organisation and functioning of the National Medicines Agency, approved as amended through Law No. 594/2002, as amended,

on seeing Approval Report of the Pharmaceutical Directorate No. MC 1.897/2005,

based on Government Decision No. 743/2003 on organisation and functioning of the Ministry of Health, as amended,

the minister of health hereby issues the following order:

Art. 1. - Approval of the Index of Medicinal Products for Human Use, 2005, including medicinal products for human use authorised for marketing by the National Medicines Agency.

Art. 2. - In addition to medicinal products registered in the Index under Article 1, domestic and imported medicinal products for human use may also be marketed in Romania that have been authorised for marketing by the National Medicines Agency after Index approval, as well as other medicinal products approved under the law by the ministry of health.

Art. 3. - The Index of Medicinal Products for Human Use, 2005, is available on the National Medicines Agency website, at <http://www.anm.ro>.

Art. 4. - Specialised directorates in the Ministry of Health, the National Medicines Agency, county and Bucharest City directorates for public health, the National Health Insurance House, county and Bucharest City insurance houses, the Defence, Public Order, National Security and Court Authority insurance houses as well as the Health Insurance House of the Minister of Transportation, Constructions and Tourism, medicinal products manufacturers, importers and distributors shall carry out provisions of this order.

Art. 5. - This order is to be published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.
